

CITING RESOURCES

Follow the sequence along with the punctuations for citing the sources properly.

Always follow the alphabetical order of authors' names while citing their works.

BOOKS

SURNAME OF THE AUTHOR, NAME OF THE AUTHOR. *NAME OF THE BOOK*.

PLACE OF PUBLICATION: PUBLISHING HOUSE, YEAR OF PUBLICATION.

MEDIUM OF PUBLICATION.

EXAMPLES

Ali, Monica. *Brick Lane*. London: Black Swan, 2004. Print.

Mukherjee, Bharati. *Desirable Daughters*. New Delhi: Rupa & Co., 2006. Print.

JOURNALS

SURNAME OF THE AUTHOR, NAME OF THE AUTHOR. "TITLE OF THE ARTICLE". NAME OF THE JOURNAL VOLUME. ISSUE (YEAR OF PUBLICATION): PAGE NUMBERS. MEDIUM OF PUBLICATION.

EXAMPLES

Aneja, Anu. "Jasmine, the Sweet Scent of Exile." *Pacific Coast Philology* 28.1 (1993): 72-80.
Print.

Byom, Svetana. "Nostalgia and its discontents." *The Hedgehog Review* 9.2 (2007): 7-18.
Print.

MAGAZINES

SURNAME OF THE AUTHOR, NAME OF THE AUTHOR. “TITLE OF THE MAGAZINE ARTICLE”. NAME OF THE MAGAZINE VOLUME. MONTH AND YEAR OF PUBLICATION: PAGE NUMBERS. MEDIUM OF PUBLICATION.

- In case of multiple authors, only the name of the first author would be reversed. That is only the surname of his/her name would come first

EXAMPLES

Hancoff, Geoff. “An Interview with Bharati Mukherjee.” *Canadian Fiction* May 1987: 30-44. Print.

Mukherjee, Bharati. “American Dreamer.” *Mother Jones* January/February 1997: 32-35. Print.

NEWS PAPER ARTICLES

SURNAME OF THE AUTHOR, NAME OF THE AUTHOR. “TITLE OF THE NEWSPAPER ARTICLE”. NAME OF THE NEWSPAPER DATE OF ITS PUBLICATION: PAGE NUMBERS. MEDIUM OF PUBLICATION.

EXAMPLES

Mukherjee, Bharati. “Immigrant Writing: Give Us Your Maximalists.” *New York Times Book Review* 28 August 1988: 28-29. Print.

Pinto, Jerry. “Bharati but American.” *The Sunday Times* 05 January 1997: 11. Print.

WEB SOURCES

AUTHOR'S LAST NAME, FIRST NAME. “TITLE OF THE ARTICLE OR INDIVIDUAL PAGE.” TITLE OF THE WEBSITE, NAME OF THE PUBLISHER, DATE OF PUBLICATION. MEDIUM OF PUBLICATION ALONG WITH THE DATE ON WHICH THIS WEBSITE WAS VISITED FOR DOWNLOADING OR VIEWING THE ARTICLE.

- In case name of the publisher is not available you may write N.p.,
- In case the date of publication is not available you may write n.d.

EXAMPLES

Ali, Monica. "Brick Lane 'Fury' Over Film Plans." *news.bbc.co.uk. BBC News*, 18 July 2006.

Web 22.02.2017.

Brown, Mike. *Voice of Experience. telegraph.co.uk. The Telegraph*, 27 May 2006. Web.18

June 2010.

Ellam, Julie. *Monica Ali. Contemporary Writers. comtemporarywriters.com. N.p., n.d. Web.*
